## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the following rules;  
World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing 2021 – 2024.

World Sailing Offshore Special Regulations Category 4.

International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea.

IRC 2022 Rules, OMR, Texel rules, respective One Design rules and respective Class rules.

- 1.2 All participating boats shall satisfy the requirements of this Regatta Safety Rules based on World Sailing OSR Category 4 for safety equipment.

- 1.3 There's no limit to the number and weight of crew, however all participating boats must adhere to their registry and insurance.

### 2.0 SPORTSMANSHIP AND THE RULES

- 2.1 Competitors in the sport of sailing are governed by a body of rules that they are expected to follow and enforce. A fundamental principle of sportsmanship is that when a boat breaks a rule and is not exonerated she will promptly take an appropriate penalty or action, which may be to retire.

### 3 ADVERTISING

- 3.1 A boat and her crew shall comply with World Sailing Regulation 20 - Advertising Code.

- 3.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

### 4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all those boats qualified and satisfies the Regatta Rules and whose owner and/or Skipper is a current member of clubs affiliated to their own national authority.

- 4.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the "Entry Form" and sending it, together with the required fee to the Organising Authority by the 30<sup>th</sup> December 2022.

- 4.3 The regatta fleet may be divided in to following classes depending on the entries received:
- i) Racing fleet
    - a) IRC
    - b) Cruising Multihull
    - c) Cruising Monohull
    - d) Classic Yacht
    - e) Racing Multihull
  - ii) Non Racing fleet
    - f) Motor Yacht Rally
    - g) Sailing Yacht Rally

## 5 FEES

- 5.1 Entry fees for this regatta are as follows:
- a) Boat entry fee : IDR6million per boat inclusive of skipper
  - b) Crew / Guest fee : IDR4million per person
- 5.2 All entries must be accompanied by a copy of the boat's current registry, insurance, MMSI and rating certificates. Registration will be closed on 30<sup>th</sup> December 2022 at 1200hrs.
- 5.3 Entry fees inclusive of berthing at Nongsa Point Marina from 14<sup>th</sup> January 2023 till 5<sup>th</sup> February 2023 and Indonesia clearance formalities.

## **11 PRIZES**

11.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top boats in the overall results in each class.

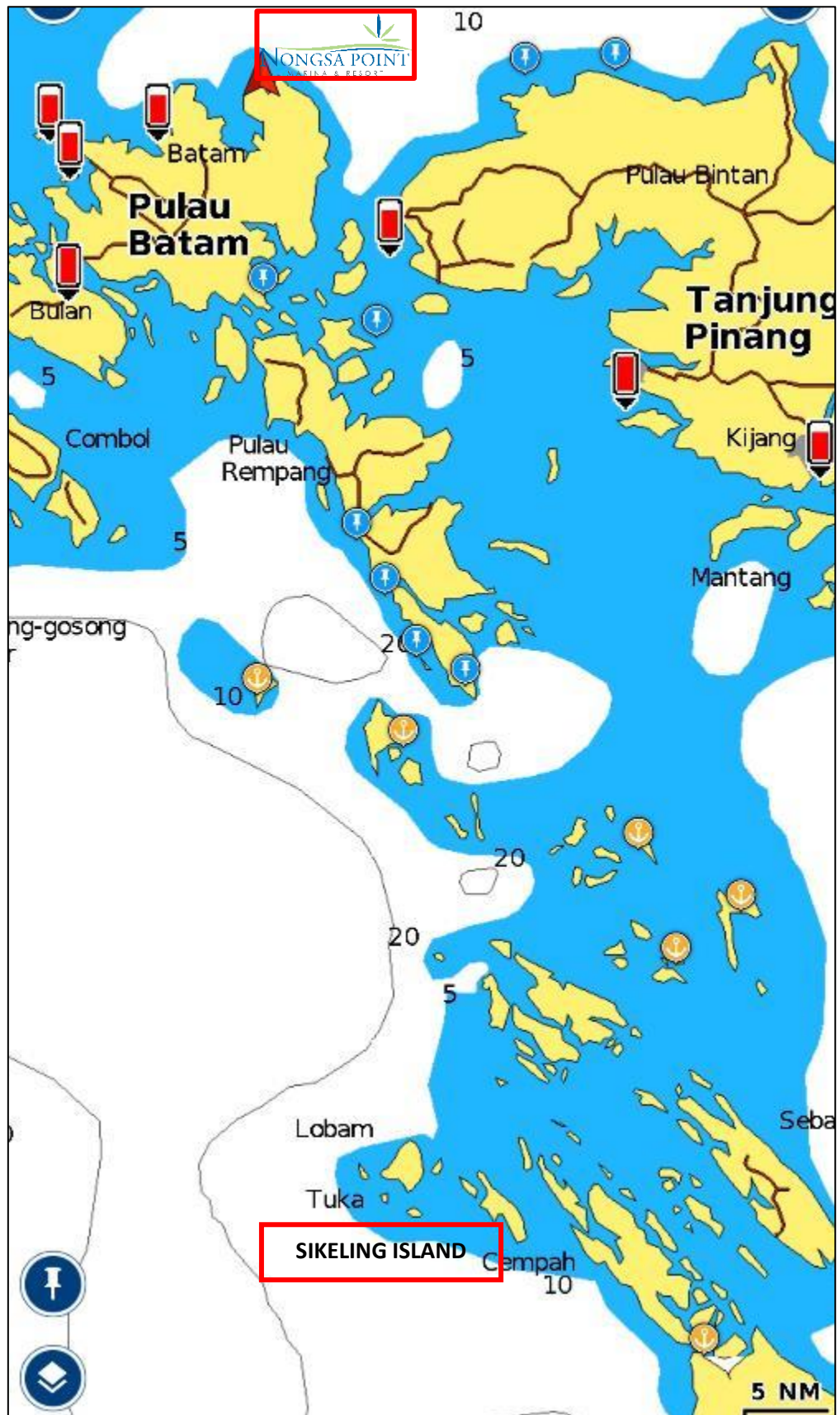
