1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the following rules;
World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing 2021 – 2024.
World Sailing Offshore Special Regulations Category 4.
International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea.
IRC 2022 Rules, OMR, Texel rules, respective One Design rules and respective Class rules.
- 1.2 All participating boats shall satisfy the requirements of this Regatta Safety Rules based on World Sailing OSR Category 4 for safety equipment.
- 1.3 There's no limit to the number and weight of crew, however all participating boats must adhere to their registry and insurance.

2 SPORTSMANSHIP AND THE RULES

- 2.1 Competitors in the sport of sailing are governed by a body of rules that they are expected to follow and enforce. A fundamental principle of sportsmanship is that when a boat breaks a rule and is not exonerated she will promptly take an appropriate penalty or action, which may be to retire.

3 ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

- 3.1 Participants are encouraged to minimize any adverse environmental impact of the sport of sailing.

4 ADVERTISING

- 4.1 A boat and her crew shall comply with World Sailing Regulation 20 - Advertising Code.
- 4.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

5 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 5.1 The regatta is open to all those boats qualified and satisfies the Regatta Rules and whose owner and/or Skipper is a current member of a club or other organisation affiliated to a World Sailing member national authority.
- 5.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the "Entry Form" and sending it, together with the required fee to the Organising Authority a week before arriving at the marina.
- 5.3 Boats may enter these following classes: Monohull PY, Monohull IRC, Catamaran, Trimaran, One Design, solo and two handed. More may be added as and when entry comes in or on request.
- 5.4 A boat may qualify for several classes suitable in one attempt. Eg Catamaran + 2 handed.

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6 FEES

- 6.1 This event is a no profit endeavour, any additional amount arising from it will be used at the award giving ceremony.
- 6.2 Entry fees for this event are IDR5million per boat. Fees paid includes of berthing at Nongsa Point Marina from 18th March to 2nd April and Indonesia CIQP formalities, excluding utilities used.
- 6.3 Fees paid will be accumulated for the year end prize giving ceremony, less the marina expenses mentioned above and the awards.
- 6.4 All entries must be accompanied by a copy of the boat's current registry, insurance and rating certificates.

7 SCHEDULE

- Registration : 24th March 2023, Friday
- Round Island Race : 25th March 2023, Saturday
- Light House Run : 26th March 2023, Sunday

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 8.1 The Sailing Instructions with full course details will be made available from 20th March 2023 at the Nongsa Point Marina & Resort and e-mailed to all registered participants.

9 COURSE

- 9.1 The course is round the Bintan Island in the clock or anti-clockwise with the start and finish line at Nongsa.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1 The Scoring Penalty, rule 44.1 and 44.2, will apply.

11 SCORING

- 11.1 Boats with the shortest finish time will be ranked top in each category.

12 RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 12.1 Boats required monitoring VHF16 while sailing in Indonesians waters.

13 PRIZES

- 13.1 An award shall be given to the boat breaking best finishing times in each class.
- 13.2 Record holders of each class name shall be displayed on the wall in the marina at a suitable location for recognitions.

14 MEDIA PUBLICITY

- 14.1 Competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority, and official event sponsors, without payment, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, recorded or filmed television of or relating to the event.

15 RISK STATEMENT

- 15.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

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16 INSURANCE

16.1 All competitors are required to have appropriate insurance coverage. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance.

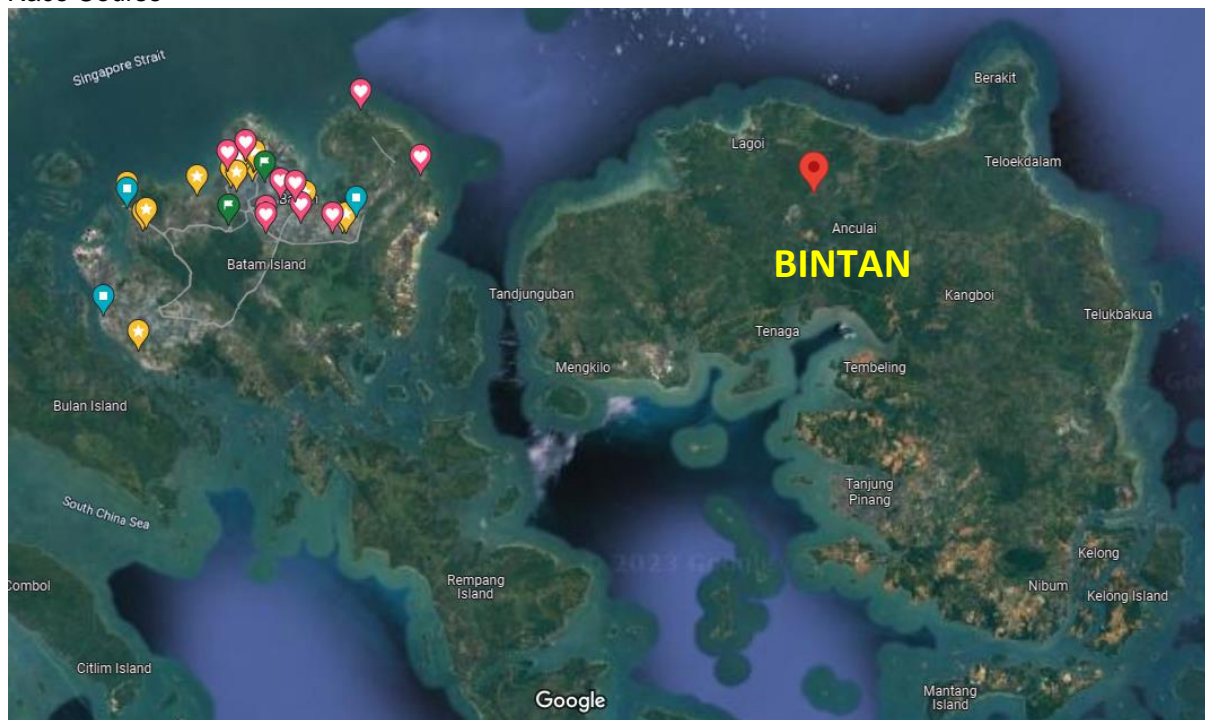
