NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the following rules;
World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing 2021 – 2024.
World Sailing Offshore Special Regulations Category 4.
International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea.
IRC 2023 Rules, OMR, Texel rules, respective One Design rules and respective Class rules.
- 1.2 All participating boats shall satisfy the requirements of this Regatta Safety Rules based on World Sailing OSR Category 4 for safety equipment.
- 1.3 There's no limit to the number and weight of crew, however all participating boats must adhere to their registry and insurance.

2 SPORTSMANSHIP AND THE RULES

- 2.1 Competitors in the sport of sailing are governed by a body of rules that they are expected to follow and enforce. A fundamental principle of sportsmanship is that when a boat breaks a rule and is not exonerated she will promptly take an appropriate penalty or action, which may be to retire.

3 ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

- 3.1 Participants are encouraged to minimize any adverse environmental impact of the sport of sailing.

4 ADVERTISING

- 4.1 A boat and her crew shall comply with World Sailing Regulation 20 - Advertising Code.
- 4.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

5 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 5.1 The regatta is open to all those boats qualified and satisfies the Regatta Rules and whose owner and/or Skipper is a current member of a club or other organisation affiliated to a World Sailing member national authority.
- 5.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the “Entry Form” and sending it, together with the required fee to the Organising Authority by the 30th December 2023.
- 5.3 The regatta fleet may be divided in to following classes depending on the entries received:
- i) Racing fleet
 - a) IRC
 - b) Cruising Multihull
 - c) Cruising Monohull
 - d) Classic Yacht
 - e) Racing Multihull
 - ii) Non Racing fleet
 - f) Motor Yacht Rally
 - g) Sailing Yacht Rally

6 FEES

- 6.1 Entry fees for this regatta are as follows:
- a) Boat entry fee : IDR10million per boat inclusive of 1 skipper
 - b) Crew / Guest fee : IDR5million per person
- 6.2 All entries must be accompanied by a copy of the boat’s current registry, insurance, MMSI and rating certificates. Registration will be closed on 30th December 2023 at 1200hrs.
- 6.3 Entry fees inclusive of berthing at Nongsa Point Marina from 1st February till 25th February 2024, Indonesia clearance formalities and regatta dinners.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

8.1 The Sailing Instructions with full course details will be made available from 1st February 2024 at the Nongsa Point Marina & Resort and e-mailed to all registered participants.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

9.1 For all classes Rule 44.1 and 44.2 applies.

10 SCORING

10.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply. A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATION

11.1 Nongsa Point Marina : VHF67

Race Officers and Regatta Operations : VHF77

12 PRIZES

12.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top boats in the overall results in each class.

13 MEDIA PUBLICITY

13.1 Competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority, and official event sponsors, without payment, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, recorded or filmed television of or relating to the event.

14 RISK STATEMENT

14.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

15 INSURANCE

15.1 All competitors are required to have appropriate insurance coverage. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance.

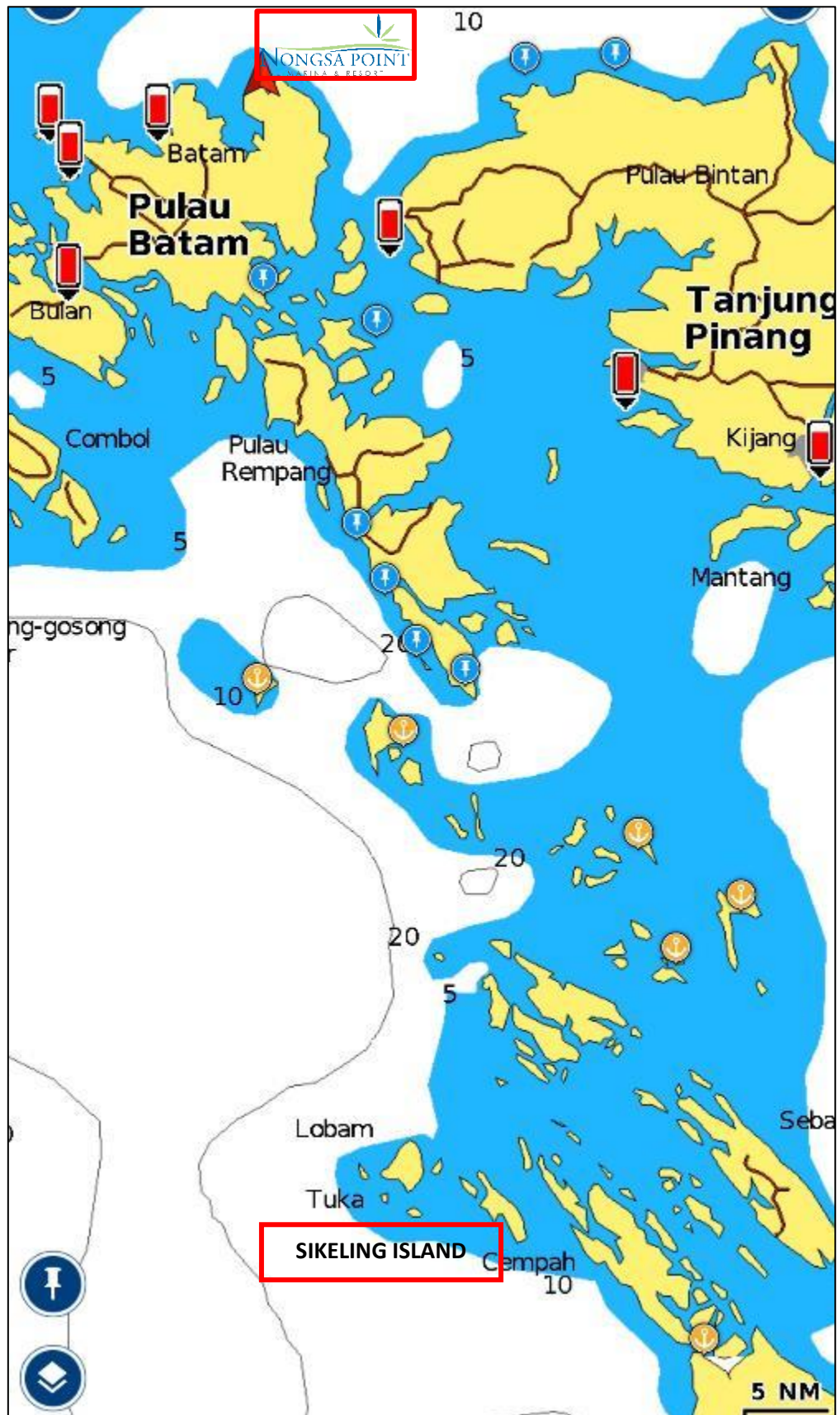
